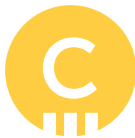

To make the choice in the organ landscape easier for your (ecclesiastical) community, we have assembled a number of high-quality models for your consideration.

The organs from the Content Chapel series are specifically built for use in churches, concert halls and institutions.

The Chapel series models are equipped with unique tonal dispositions and the (solid) wooden organ furniture can all be closed with a rolltop. The organs are distinguished based on the different series in our Invention Technology®.

In addition, we also offer the option of placing a Hauptwerk organ or a hybrid instrument in your (church) space.

Chapel 227R



The basic model in our Chapel series uses our Clavis Technology®. With this technique, the audio is divided over 6 channels, and the price-quality ratio is excellent.

The organ offered in this category is the Chapel 227R. This organ is equipped with two keyboards and choice of pedal board. The organ has 27 voices, with a high sound quality. The pedal division, equipped with 7 pedal voices, provides a solid foundation for the also very important Great division. With an extensive Swell division, the organist has an opportunity to create meaningful dynamics or play with various timbres. Thanks to four different organ styles, a wide repertoire is possible on this organ.

The Chapel 227R is available in a variation where the speakers are built-in internally or in a variant with an external audio system.

The Chapel 227R is recommended for use as an organ in an auditorium, community room, small churches or in a chapel. Of course, the desired use depends entirely on the room in which the instrument is placed.

The Chapel models with Celeste Technology® offer amazing tonal flexibility and extensive audio possibilities.

The external audio arrangement is 6 channels, with an internal monitor system being an option. Connecting extra speakers or subwoofers is no problem. Voicing according to personal preference is also possible, with using the Personal Control Centre or the Content Voicing Software.

In the Celeste series we offer the Chapel 236R and the Chapel 340R. These organs have 36 and 40 speaking voices respectively. Their tonal dispositions are composed of high-quality sampled pipe organs. The sound can be characterized as “open, fresh and powerful”. The robust oak cabinet (with roller shutter) gives the console a solid and contemporary look. The Chapel 236R comes with lighted TAB-stops and the Chapel 340R comes standard with lighted stops.

Musical flexibility is at the forefront in the series that uses Cantate Technology®. Thanks to our exclusive Invention Technology®, it is no problem with this series to intone the organ to your own wishes and taste. A 8- or 10-channel audio system (expandable to at least 24 channels) offers Content maximum flexibility in distributing the sound throughout the room. With this technique we have all possibilities for a customized installation available for your (church)room and organist team.

The organs offered in this category are the Chapel 246R, the Chapel 346R and the Chapel 354R. These organs are characterized by their unparalleled sound quality and detailed tonal reproduction. With 46 or 54 speaking registers, combined with 128 ExtraVoice voices, the organist is offered an almost endless range of tones. Both the Chapel 246R and Chapel 354R are offered with lighted draw stops, or, optionally also with real wood or mechanical draw stops. This way, playing a Content Chapel organ is a great playing experience!

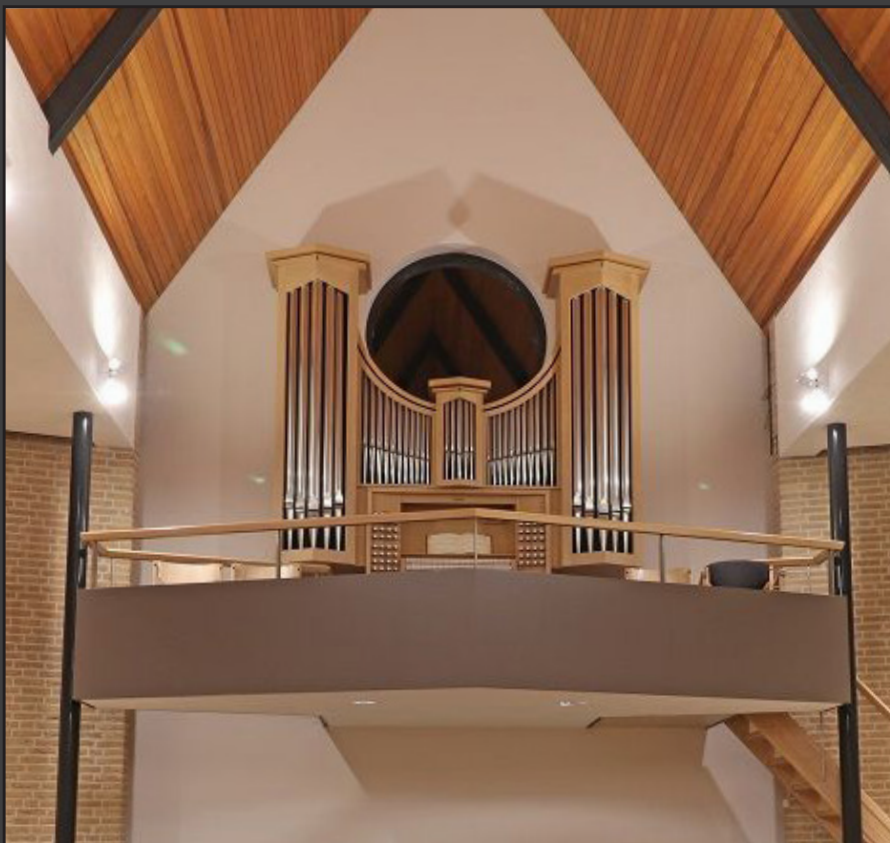
